- Cardboard remember to flatten cardboard before placing it into your wheelie bin

- Plastics bottles, pots, tubs and trays
- **Glass** bottles and iars
- Tins and cans food tins and drinks cans
- Aerosol containers deodorants and furniture sprays
- Food cartons liquid food and drink cartons
- Lids metal lids from jars and bottles
- Foil kitchen foil and food containers

Please rinse and flatten your recycling before putting it into your green box and remove lids from plastic bottles and cartons.

All cooked and uncooked food waste including:

- Meat and fish (including shellfish and bones)
- Fruit and vegetable (including peelings)
- Bread, cakes, rice, pasta
- Tea bags and coffee grounds
- Pet food
- **Cut flowers**
- Mouldy and out of date food

Non-recyclable waste

- Plastic carrier bags
- Plastic film
- Pet litter
- Disposable nappies
- **Animal bedding**
- **Polystyrene**



Batteries and small electrical items are



now collected for recycling on the same vehicles that empty your black wheelie bin.

Space is limited so we ask that you only put out one small electrical item per month. All batteries should be tied in a carrier bag.
